# WHAT IS IT?



## Summer School for Junior Magistrates

- RAI Secretariat's training project for young practitioners – investigators, prosecutors and judges, dealing with anti-corruption;
- Organizers – Co-organization between RAI Secretariat and the National Institute of Justice of Republic of Bulgariaia;
- Financing – RAI Secretariat – member states' funds



## ABOUT THE PROJECT



- Launched in 2006 as an annual project
- Represents a forum for cooperation and exchange of knowledge
- Framework – 2 participants per member state
  - lecture sessions
  - final evaluation: case study
  - certification



## PROGRAM OF THE PROJECT



6th edition of the ***Summer School*** consists of five thematic panels:

- I. International standards in anti-corruption – the implementation of relevant conventions of United Nations and Council of Europe
- II. Reform of judiciary and anti-corruption as challenges to the EU accession process
- III. Anti-corruption policies and preventive measures – available tools and best practices
- IV. EU experience regarding the international judicial cooperation in criminal matters



## EXPECTED OUTCOMES



- Achieving general knowledge, as well as some specific knowledge about the recent developments on the anti-corruption field – legislation, specialized bodies, initiatives, projects, cooperation mechanisms.
- Exchange of ideas and good practices in the area
